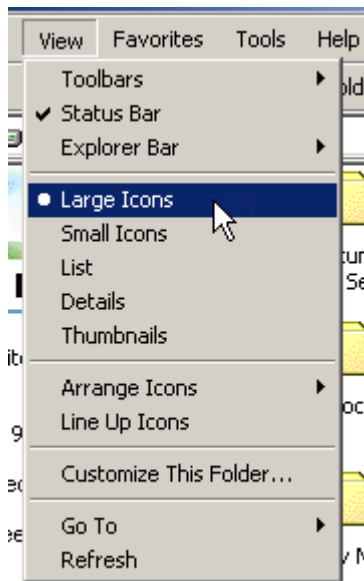


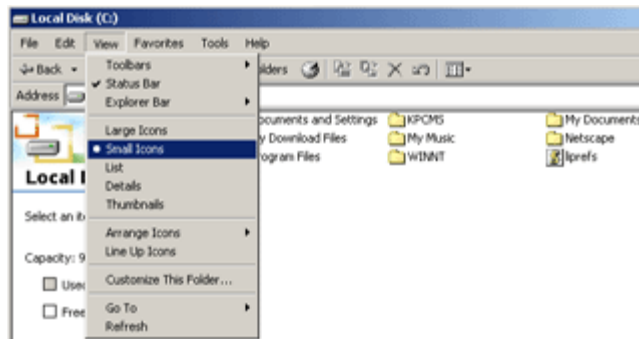
Change the File View

Step 1: Show Large Icons



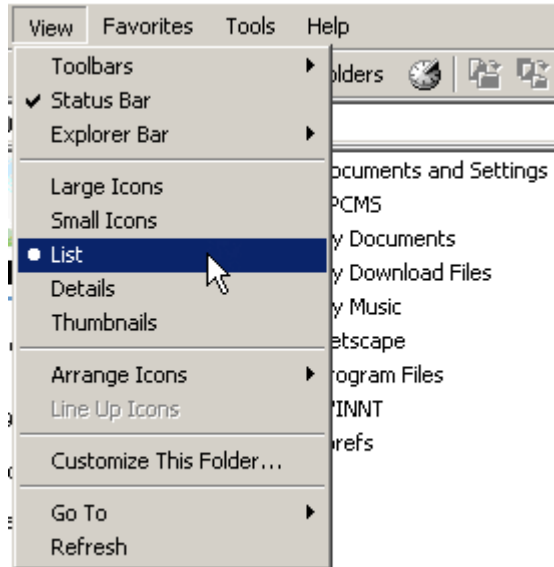
You can use the View menu in a My Computer folder window to change how the files appear: as icons or as a listing. If a folder has very few files, you may prefer to work with large icons. To display large icons, choose View, Large Icons.

Step 2: Show Small Icons



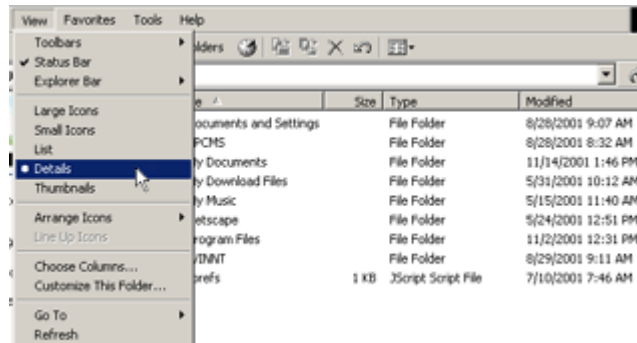
To see smaller icons with the folders and file names arranged in rows across the top of the folder window, choose View, Small Icons.

Step 3: Display the List View



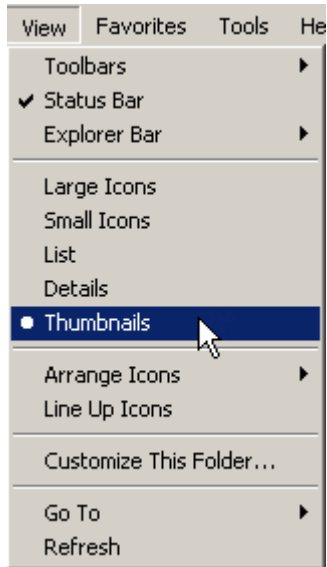
The List view resembles the Small Icons view, except the files appear in a list down the column rather than across the top of the window. To display the List view, choose View, List from the folder window menu bar.

Step 4: List File Details



You can display additional details about each file in a folder, such as the file size and type. To change to the Details view, choose View, Details.

Step 5: Show Thumbnails



If a folder holds image files and you want to be able to see a thumbnail preview of what the image file looks like, choose View, Thumbnails.
